Dear parent/carer

As you will know, the Prime Minister has announced that schools will re-open on Monday 8 March and I am very much looking forward to welcoming pupils back to Castle Academy.

Castle Academy Covid 19 entry to the school site plans from March 8th 2021

Please note that only FS2 and Jaguar's Class parents will be allowed on site to accompany their children. All other parents must wait outside of the school site. We have allocated time slots to minimise congestion.

FS2 and Cougars access and exit







Year 1 parents will use the **second gate** at the Low Road entrance which is labelled Year 1. Please press the buzzer to gain access. Your child will then enter the school building through the office courtyard, through the gate and into the building (the children are familiar with this access point.)

Arrival between-8.40-8.50 am.

Home time -2.45pm.

Miss Gelder will escort the children into the office courtyard to supervise a socially distanced pick up. Please wait in the area leading up to the school office. If this area is congested please wear a face mask.

Year 2 will use the 2nd gate on the Station Road entrance which is labelled Year 2. Parents are asked not to enter the site.

Arrival between- **8.40- 8.50 am**. Mrs Mason will supervise the arrival. Home time **-2.50 pm**.

Mrs Harrop/ Mrs Bradley will escort the children onto the KS1 playground to supervise pick up. Parents visible from the gate.


